In May 2022, the Making Space 365 learning teaching training activity was held in the beautiful city of Kalamata in Greece. Partner organisations from Portugal, Greece, Germany, Ireland, Lithuania and the United Kingdom sent two front-line youth educators and youth leaders to implement and test the Making Space 365 Creative Skills & Entrepreneurship Youth Training Curriculum.

This was a fantastic opportunity for youth and community education staff and participants to become familiar with the Making Space 365 project, participate in a hands-on transnational training experience, and share different approaches with their youth leader peers from overseas.

Participants improved their professional ability to promote creative and entrepreneurial competencies for young people through blended learning environments and training. It was also an opportunity to gain awareness of young people's difficulties and obstacles on their way to employment and civic engagement.
